FOR INFORMATION PURPOSES: Trail network agreement indicates County will design and hire and supervise contractor for project. The contractor must provide insurance coverage limits that meet FDOT minimums as shown in agreement 440093 1 54 01 Sect. 14 C. (workers comp and General liability 1M Occurrence 5M Aggregate) Agreement also has indemnification language in favor of FDOT. Agreement is PE to PE but requires FDOT listed as additional insured on all certificates of insurance for contractors and sub-contractors on project. See 14. E. Duke Energy may also be required to be listed as AI on all Certificates of Insurance for Contractors and Sub-contractors pursuant to this agreement. No limits of coverage indicated. If project involves railroad right of way Railroad protective liability with a minimum amount of 2M occurrence and 6M aggregate and naming of FDOT and Railroad as additional insured

NOTES: Agreement is necessary to in order to provide grant funding toward the completion of design and construction of the North end of the Pinellas Trail Loop. The County application was approved for 5.7 M to complete the 9.6 miles of the north gap of the Pinellas Trail. Pinellas County will manage the Trail design and construction.
