Description & Comments

This item is a sub-recipient agreement between Pinellas County and The Gulf Consortium (Consortium). It is a federal pass-through grant awarded by Gulf Ecosystem Restoration Council (RESTORE Council). The Florida State Expenditure Plan (FSEP), approved by the RESTORE Council on 10/1/18, included FSEP Project 16-3 or Pinellas County CIP project 005120A - RESTORE Land Acquisition for Floodplain Restoration and Resiliency. The federal award subject to the Consortium Subrecipient Agreement with Pinellas County is \$3,321,056.00. This agreement begins upon execution and expires January 31, 2026.

005120A - RESTORE Land Acquisition for Floodplain Restoration and Resiliency is budgeted in the approved FY24-FY29 Capital Improvement Program plan and funded by this federal pass-through grant with the Consortium. The grant award and project budget in the CIP plan is \$3,021,000.00 but can be adjusted to match the award amount outlined in the agreement during the FY25 budget development cycle, if approved.

Funding through this agreement would be provided on a cost reimbursement basis for work performed on or after effective date through project completion date. Pre-award costs may be eligible for reimbursement (must be approved by RESTORE Council). There is no required County match.

- Project Scope: "Acquisition of properties in flood hazard areas within Pinellas County to be maintained in perpetuity for conservation and floodplain storage to support coastal resiliency and environmental sustainability."
- Federal award from the RESTORE Council is \$3,374,518.00, of which, the Consortium will retain \$53,462.00 for administration. The balance of \$3,321,056.00 is the federal award to Pinellas County.
