This project will increase the structural integrity and hazard resistance capacity of eight (8) Pinellas County Utilities (PCU) and City of St Petersburg Water Resources Department (WRD) operations facilities, which are currently used for countywide water and sewer emergency operations. Recent assessment studies determined that utility operated buildings were at risk to eith wind or flood famge.
