Restoration of key critical infrastructures and operation facilities (water and sewer facilities); Building or fortifying operations facilities that are essential to public health, safety and welfare of our community (other public properties).

Description:

This project will increase the structural integrity and hazard resistance capacity of eight (8) Pinellas County Utilities (PCU) and City of St Petersburg Water Resources Department (WRD) operations facilities, which are currently used for countywide water and sewer emergency operations. Recent assessment studies determined that utility operated buildings were at risk to either wind or flood damage.
