Description & Comments

The Office of Fleet and Asset Management (OFAM) under the County Administrator is seeking Board of County Commissioner approval of the award of bid to Global Montello Group Corp, Petroleum Traders Cooperation, Port Consolidated, Inc., and Pro-Energy, as a Tampa Bay Area Purchasing Cooperative Contract, for requirements of gasoline and diesel (Table 1). Awarded through a competitive Invitation to Bid process effective April 10, 2025, the contract allows Pinellas County and eight other entities (Dunedin, Gulfport, Oldsmar, Pinellas Park, St. Petersburg, Palm Harbor Fire Rescue, St. Petersburg College, and Tampa Bay Water) to purchase fuel at negotiated pricing. The cooperative contract has a not-to-exceed threshold of \$36,258,426.00 for a term of 36-months. Cooperative participants are responsible for issuance of their own awards and funding, which is \$6,424,918.37, less County requirements.

The cooperative contract features index-based pricing tied to the daily Oil Price Information Service (OPIS) Port of Tampa average rack price, adjusted by a fixed fee per gallon outlined in the bid tabulation. Prices automatically escalate or de-escalate every 12 months (or sooner if the Consumer Price Index changes ≥3%), and the County may request adjustments at any time with supporting documentation. The initial 36 month term may be renewed for one additional 24 month period by mutual consent, and the County reserves the right to add or delete delivery locations and services unilaterally.

Funding for this cooperative contract is included in the FY26 Operating Budget for OFAM in the Fleet Management Fund. A total of \$6,205,380 was confirmed by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) in the FY26 Adopted Budget for fuel. In the event that future fiscal year funding is not available for this cooperative contract, the County maintains the authority to terminate this agreement.
