Proposed Abstract (Project Scope of Work)
Project Abstract
 In an effort to prevent recidivism of juvenile girls, their substance abuse, foster the success of drug exposed children, improve family functioning, and reduce trauma, Pinellas County will train a Family Dependency Treatment Court (FDTCT). FDTCT consists of judge, prosecutor, counselor, drug treatment, 27 parents who have been adjudicated consistent with substance abuse being a primary cause of the child neglect or abuse. FDTCT is a voluntary, one-year program that provides treatment opportunities before a trial court judge, addresses child assessment and treatment, parenting classes, and limited counseling services. The program will be implemented into existing courts through court-ordered case planning. Operation of the FDTCT will follow the Ten Key Components of a Drug Court and the General Characteristics of Family Dependency Treatment.
 Eligible participants meet the DDMIV criteria for drug/criminal dependency, are at least 18 years of age, and the parent or legal custodian who have custody or who are requesting custody/visitation. The program aims to serve 30-50 parents and their children annually.
 The effectiveness of the FDTCT will be assessed through the annual data reporting, Family Change in substance abuse patterns, drug court graduation, recurrence of child abuse, improved parenting skills, family reunification, and avoidance of termination of parental rights.

Benefit Summary (How will this benefit the County, Dept, etc.): Enhanced the Family Dependency Treatment Court to ensure permanent, stable homes for children by creating healthy, drug-free families through treatment and sustained judicial supervision.
