Description & Comments

(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.)

This item is requesting approval to apply for the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Climate Resilience Regional Challenge 2024 grant program. The Public Works Department is requesting funding in the amount of \$39,001,310.00 for Joe's Creek Greenway Trail and Channel Restoration project and the Lealman Exchange Resilience Hub. This is a cost reimbursement-based grant with no match requirement. The grant application deadline is February 13th, 2024.

The total project estimate being used for this grant is \$84,033,205.25 and includes the following:

- Joe's Creek Greenway Trail and Channel Restoration (CIP project 004116A): \$59,482,000.00
- U.S. 19/34th St. N. Crossing Improvements (FDOT box culvert), not a budgeted County project: \$16,194,000.00
- LEX Resilience Hub (Gym Upgrade & Hardening and Workforce Development), not a budgeted County project: \$3,500,000.00.
- Public Art-Place Making, not a budgeted County project: \$3,000,000.00
- NOAA Grant Administration, not a budgeted County project: \$1,857,205.25

Joe's Creek Greenway Trail and Channel Restoration (004116A) is budgeted in the FY24-FY29 CIP plan for \$55,129,000.00 and funded by Local Infrastructure Sales Surtax (Penny for Pinellas) as well as federal, state, and local grants. Although the latest project estimate has increased to \$59,482,000. Award of the NOAA grant would reduce the amount of Penny for Pinellas funding needed to support this current estimate. Additionally, Joe's Creek Greenway Trail and Channel Restoration has been selected for Florida Department of Environmental Protection funding in the amount of \$27,911,500. Upon Board approval of any of the grants, adjustments to the project budget will be made.

U.S. 19/34th St. N. Crossing Drainage Improvements for Joe's Creek (FDOT box culvert) estimate of \$16,194,000.00 is not included in the Joe's Creek Greenway Trail and Channel Restoration budget but NOAA grant funding request includes the full \$16,194,000 FDOT box culvert estimate. No Penny funding is requested. Public Works is also seeking funding opportunities with Florida Department of Transportation. These drainage improvements may be submitted as a new CIP project related to but separate from Joe's Creek Greenway Trail and Channel Restoration.

LEX Resilience Hub (Gym Upgrade & Hardening and Workforce Development) estimated at \$3,500,000.00 and Public Art-Place Making estimated \$3,000,000.00 are not budgeted and will be new project requests that are anticipated to be fully grant funded with this NOAA grant, if awarded.

The total NOAA grant project estimate includes an estimate of \$1,857,205.25 for NOAA Grant Administration. This is included in the grant funding request. This estimate will need to be broken down and included in the County project estimate for each project listed above.

- Joe's Creek Greenway Trail and Channel Restoration (004116A) is budgeted in the FY24-FY29 CIP plan for \$55,129,000.00. The remainder of the project estimate being used for this grant is not budgeted and will require new project requests. If the NOAA grant is not awarded, these projects will not move forward.
- NOAA grant award anticipated to reduce Penny funding needed in the FY24-FY29 CIP plan for Joe's Creek Greenway Trail and Channel Restoration (004116A), however, it will be important to ensure enough Penny funding will remain in the project budget to fulfill match requirements for other grantor agreements.
