This is for the approval and execution by County Administrator for the Purchase Authorization with Evans Consoles to purchase eleven (11) Regional 9-1-1 Call-Taker Training Consoles. The Agreement will provide for the delivery and installation of a quantity of eleven (11) furniture consoles workstations for a total amount of \$326,566.46, effective through delivery, installation, and acceptance by the County. The Agreement enhances the training environment for 9-1-1 telecommunications that mimics the live environment and increases the number of live consoles.

The \$326,566.46 was not included in the FY23 Adopted budget and the required budget resolution to record the funds into the Emergency Communications E911 System Fund took place on 8-15-23 and was approved.
