This resolution is a request to include the Long Key-Upham 9th Nourishment, 004487A, in the Florida Beach Management Funding Assistance Program Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Long-Range Budget Plan of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) and apply for grant funding.

The Long Key-Upham 9th Nourishment project, 004487A, is anticipated to have \$4,094,325.00 in eligible costs for State grant funding. \$1,325,000.00 of which was previously awarded through FDEP and has an equal County match funded by Tourist Development Tax. Through this item, the County is requesting an additional \$722,162.50 from FDEP which will require an equal County match, to be funded by TDT.

Construction and monitoring costs reflected in this resolution for Long Key-Upham 9th Nourishment project, 004487A, are budgeted in the Proposed FY26-FY31 Capital Improvement Plan and funded by Tourist Development Tax (TDT) and a State grant with FDEP. If FDEP awards additional grant funding for Long Key-Upham 9th Nourishment project, 004487A, it will offset TDT funding.
