This is for the approval of the award of bid to Hubbard Construction Company for FY 2025-2027 Countywide Pavement Preservation – Rebid. This contract is for milling, resurfacing, application of pavement markings, and installation of traffic detector loops along various arterial, collector, and local roadways throughout the County as well as certain park roads. A total of four bids were received from Hubbard Construction Company (\$18,904,436.7421), Preferred Materials (\$19,802,401.00), Ajax Paving Industries of Florida, LLC (\$20,428,534.45), and SUPERIOR ASPHALT, INC (\$26,155,001.00). Recommended award is to the lowest and most responsive bidder, Hubbard Construction Company. This bid came in 10.09% under the engineer’s estimate of \$21,026,758.33. The contract is issued in a not to exceed amount of \$18,904,436.74. All work is to be completed within 540 consecutive calendar days. Work will commence once a notice to proceed has been issued by the County. Funding for this contract is not specifically represented in the FY26-FY31 Capital Improvement Plan because the contract establishes a not to exceed value, with obligation occurring upon issuance of work order assignments (purchase orders). Funding is determined by the individual work order assignment sourced to the agreement, and actual expenditures are contingent upon work completed. The Department may appropriate the full not-to-exceed amount or less. Work orders will primarily be funded by the Road Resurfacing & Rehabilitation Program Project 004192A, funded by the Penny for Pinellas, and the Transportation Millage Capital Resurfacing Program Project 005700A, funded by the transportation millage. In the event that future fiscal year funding is not available for this project, the County maintains the authority to terminate this agreement.
