<p>The certification of financial responsibility certifies that Pinellas County has legally committed to maintaining the financial resources required to close, plug, and abandon underground injection wells and related monitoring wells in accordance with Chapter 62-528, Florida Administrative Code. The certification requires that the cost estimate for plugging and abandonment be periodically updated for inflation and revised if it increases by more than 10%, ensuring adequate financial responsibility. The current estimate for all three wells is \$640,000.00.</p> <p>This obligation is not budgeted in the current year budget of the Utilities Department. The submission of the applications, including the certification of financial responsibility, creates an obligation if the injection wells are abandoned. There is no fiscal impact unless abandonment occurs. If abandonment of the wells does occur, a budget amendment will be submitted to Board of County Commissioners to make funding available from the Utilities Revenue and Operating Fund - Reserves Contingencies.</p>
