NOTES: The purpose of the Second Amendment is to incorporate State and Federal funding revisions and administrative changes requested by the State of Florida. These administrative changes do not incur any additional costs to the County.

VEH – County provides facilities and insures buildings and furnishings and equipment:

- 7. FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT. The parties mutually agree that:
- a. CHO facilities shall be provided as specified in Attachment IV to this contract and the County shall own the facilities used by the CHO unless otherwise provided in Attachment IV.
- b. Except as otherwise provided in Attachment IV hereto, the County shall ensure adequate fire and casualty insurance coverage for County-owned CHO offices and buildings and for all furnishings and equipment in CHO offices through either a self-insurance program or insurance purchased by the County.
- c. All vehicles will be transferred to the ownership of the County and registered as County vehicles unless otherwise provided in Attachment IV. The County shall ensure insurance coverage for all County-owned vehicles is available through either a self-insurance program or insurance purchased by the County. All vehicles will be used solely for CHO operations. Vehicles purchased through the County Health Department Trust Fund shall be sold at fair market value when they are no longer needed by the CHO and the proceeds returned to the County Health Department Trust Fund. VEH note, Attachment IV states that the State will own vehicles and insure them.
