**A RESOLUTION OF THE PINELLAS COUNTY
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 05-59 AND
TERMINATING THE MUNICIPAL RECYCLING
REIMBURSEMENT GRANT PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2005, the Board of County Commissioners (the “Board”) adopted Resolution No. 05-59, creating the Municipal Recycling Reimbursement Grant Program (the “Program”); and

WHEREAS, the Program reimbursed municipalities for expenditures directly related to and supporting recycling, funded through the County Solid Waste Department Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Program has successfully supported countywide recycling efforts for two decades; and

WHEREAS, the Board now finds that the Program has fulfilled its intended purpose and that other strategies and priorities will better advance the County’s long-term solid waste and diversion goals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners, duly assembled on this ____ day of _____, 2026, as follows:

SECTION 1. The recitals above are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. Resolution No. 05-59 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The Municipal Recycling Reimbursement Grant Program is hereby terminated, effective 10/1/2026.

SECTION 4. Any outstanding reimbursements properly submitted prior to the effective date shall be processed in accordance with existing procedures.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
