Enclosed is our check in the amount of \$13,221,471.88 which represents unspent funds for Fiscal Year 2023-2024.

The amount above includes \$63,171.88 of unexpended grant funds, and \$13,158,300.00 of unspent operating and capital funds for the Pursuit Driving Training Facility, ATIMS Jail Project, Countywide CAD system, FY24 vehicles, and Family Reunification Center.
