Review & Comments

OMB Grants Administration has conducted a review of the **Utilities** intent to apply for the **Resilient Florida** funded by **Florida Department of Environmental Protection**.

Project Scope of Work

The request is for construction dollars to upgrade the existing Reclaimed Water High Service Pump Station (RCW HSPS) at the South Cross Bayou Advanced Water Reclamation Facility (SCBAWRF) in St. Petersburg, FL. Improvements are needed to replace the mechanical, electrical, and instrumentation and control components, bringing the pump station up to current standards while also increasing the pumping capacity to meet future demands. In addition, improvements are needed to address flood mitigation and storm surge resiliency considerations to protect critical electrical assets.

Resilient Infrastructure and Environment and Healthy and Safe Communities

Anticipated Impact to the County Budget

This is a **Multi Year** grant potentially affecting **FY27, FY28, FY29, and FY30**. The application request is for **\$15,000,000.00** with a **\$15,000,000.00** cost share requirement. The total project budget is **\$30,000,000.00**.
