







Your Wholesale Drinking Water Provider

 Two Points of Connection at Keller Water Treatment Plants






Regional Water Sources Use October - Present



The 2018 water supply is based on the most effective use to meet projected water needs taking into account demand, cost, environment and regulatory compliance.




Regional Water Demands
