The current betting is not sufficient to keep the balls in the field of play and not cause damage to property or injury to fans.

(Required)	<p>Gorilla Netting will install four new Baseball Netting System at 120'L x 35'H (AG), on new wood poles, using #36 1-7/8" knotted nylon netting and powerline/utility grade hardware and wire rope.</p> <p>All of your netting panels will be custom-built for your installation.</p> <p>The netting system will ensure all baseballs/softballs that are hit will stay in the field of play and not damage surrounding homes or cause injuries to fans or bystanders. The total cost of the project will be \$74,930.87 with funding coming from Palm Harbor National Little league.</p>
