### Description & Comments

This is for approval by the County Administrator of Modification No. 6 to the Grant Agreement with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) for Fine Particulate Matter Ambient Air Monitoring Network Support. The primary objective of this project is to collect quality assured data on ambient air concentrations of fine particulate matter as well as chemical composition and precursors in accordance with USEPA requirements and standards.

Modification No. 6 provides for an increase in the amount of \$94,579.00 USEPA grant funds for project period April 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025. USEPA will reimburse County 100% of project costs - no County match is required.

Funding for this grant is included in the current year budget of Public Works in the Air Quality General Fund.
