Cate Lee and Derek Kilborn, City of St. Petersburg staff, discussed two planning initiatives being pursued by their city. They displayed maps showing the locations of the Innovation District and Warehouse Arts District. Referring to the St. Petersburg Innovation District Visioning Summary document, they outlined the details of each district and the future plans the city is pursuing for each. B. Linda Fisher, Forward Pinellas staff, reviewed the process for amendments to Special Area Plans (SAPs) that were adopted prior to August 2015. She outlined how those plans fit into the new tiered amendment process. This included how to determine the SAPs' equivalent Activity Center and Multimodal Corridor subcategories utilizing the Transit-Oriented Land Use Vision Map and the new plan rules. She reviewed sample scenarios for further clarification and cited potential Countywide Rule changes for consideration. PAC members then discussed the potential changes to include options for calculating transient accommodations.
