Pinellas County, in coordination with its twenty-four municipalities, is seeking funding to create a countywide flood mitigation action plan. The plan will benefit local governments by providing more precise data and mechanisms to address flood risks, as well as encourage civic responsibility of residents and business through education. The effort, as envisioned, is anticipated to generate data that can be shared among all with the intent of developing a series of strategies that are beneficial to the broader area and are finalized through effective collaboration. The foundation of such as assessment is based in good information, and resources available to obtain that information is the basic element of this request

The planning effort will leverage the recent state-approved Local Mitigation Strategy and an on-going vulnerability assessment that is evaluating future tidal and storm surge inundation. Pinellas County has invested in producing exposure mapping for coastal concerns (SLR and storm surge) ripe for asset-based risk assessments. Risk assessment quantifies the likelihood of the asset being exposed to the hazard (e.g., flooding) and the consequences if the asset is exposed. Pinellas County is currently assessing the monetized risk values for a select number of roadways. As proposed in this application, this approach can be expanded to include all potential stressors for exposed asset types or community assets already identified in the County. The specific funding ask of this application is too help pay for the generation of building and facility profiles through ground survey, combined with that assessment of precipitation-based flooding potential now and into the future. This information will be combined with the products of other efforts being undertaken currently by the County to create a comprehensive understanding of long-term risk as a foundation for better decision making.

This project will include precipitation and temperature modeling under future climate conditions, collection of terrestrial Lidar data on the first-floor elevation of structures, the conduct of an asset exposure analyses for a suite of County/municipal owned assets located county-wide, the assessment assets at greatest risk based on costs to repair and service loss consequences to the communities, and develop a multi-decade flood mitigation plan that is tied to local comprehensive planning, capital improvement projects and enterprise asset management.
