Description & Comments

Human Services is requesting the approval of grant award from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) for the Treatment for Individuals Experiencing Homelessness (TIEH) grant program.

- The SAMHSA TIEH award will expand capacity of services, including case management, recovery support services, evidence based mental health and substance abuse treatment services, and/or housing navigation to individuals who have, or are currently or are at-risk of experiencing homelessness, and have serious mental illness, substance abuse disorder (SUD), and/or co-occurring disorder.
- The federal grant award is \$499,999.00 per year, for up to five years, totaling \$2,499,995.00 for the period of 9/30/2024 through 9/29/2029.
- The County will partner with the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office - Pinellas Safe Harbor, Boley Centers, and Personal Enrichment through Mental Health Services to serve 320 clients over the five-year period.
- There are no match or cost sharing requirements.
- Funding for this grant was not anticipated in the FY25 budget and may require a budget resolution to recognize the unanticipated grant revenue and appropriate the expenditures for this program.

Fiscal Impact:

The five-year federal grant award totals \$2,499,995.00 with an allocation of \$499,999.00 per year. There is no match required.
