Soccer fields 5-8 have a large swale on the east side which limits the functionality of this group of fields. These fields also suffer from poor drainage.

The balance of the project will be funded by the soccer organization, Gulf Coast United Soccer Club, Inc., who coordinates the soccer program as part of SJWAA.</p>
