Description & Comments

(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.)

This contract is a Local Agency Participation (LAP) Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), which allocates Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funding to repair critical infrastructure along the Dunedin Causeway which was damaged by Hurricane Helene in September 2024.

This agreement allocates \$1,317,790.00 to the Dunedin Causeway repairs on a reimbursement basis, with a \$105,424.00 local match. Essentially, this match represents 7% of the total project cost and will come in the form of funding from the General Fund Reserves which will not be reimbursed.

While this is not a budgeted item, funding is available via the General Fund reserves for eligible Hurricane Helene repairs of County property. As 93% of this project will be reimbursed and the funding is spread across three fiscal years should the design and repair process require that time, the overall fiscal impact is minimal.
