Description & Comments

Human Services is requesting the approval of the Second Amendment with Unite USA, Inc. d/b/a Unite Us (Unite Us) for the Pinellas County Behavioral Health Coordinated Access Model (Care About Me).

- This Second Amendment allows for a contract extension through September 30, 2027; furthermore, the department requests that either delegated authority be provided to the Purchasing Director to terminate the agreement for convenience so the contract can effectively terminate within a matter of days.
- This Amendment will allow for the continuation of CAM with Unite Us while the Human Services Department transitions to a new, competitively procured CAM Team provider to utilize an internal CAM Platform developed with county-owned technology.
- The First Amendment updated terms and conditions. It provided for Unite Us to serve as the primary provider for Care About Me, to perform initial behavioral health assessments, triage, and set appointments with service providers; integrate with crisis care; and provide connections to telehealth psychiatry and prescription provider consultations, when appropriate.
- An amount not to exceed \$1,368,675.49 will be allocated from City/County Opioid Settlement Funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2027 for this amendment. While budgeting for the entire FY to avoid a potential lapse in programming, the program is anticipated to be terminated for convenience within the first quarter of FY27.

Contract No. 22-0101-P(DG) with the total not-to-exceed amount of \$9,158,372.76, effective through September 30, 2027, with no fiscal impact. Funding for this fiscal year 2027 will be derived from City/County Opioid Settlement Funds.

This amendment has no fiscal impact.
