## HUMAN SERVICES FUNDING AGREEMENT FIRST AMENDMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT, effective upon the date executed below, by and between PINELLAS COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter called the "COUNTY," and BOLEY CENTERS INC., a non-profit Florida corporation, whose address is 445 31st Street North, St. Petersburg, FL 33713, hereinafter called the "AGENCY." The Parties hereby amend the Human Services Funding Agreement (Agreement) between the COUNTY and AGENCY dated August 23, 2022, as follows:

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, as part of the 2023 fiscal year budget the **COUNTY** approved cost of living increases for certain programs including the program funded by the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** desires to utilize a portion of the funds available out of Pinellas County's General Fund to assist social service agencies within Pinellas County; and

WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** recognizes that the **AGENCY** is providing an essential service within the community; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

- The above "WHEREAS" clauses are incorporated into and are made a part of this Agreement.
- 2. Section 4(a), Compensation is hereby amended to add:

Beginning October 1, 2022, the COUNTY agrees to pay the AGENCY an amount not to exceed SEVEN HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-TWO DOLLARS and FORTY-FIVE CENTS (\$703,362.45) per fiscal year for the services described in Section 2 of this Agreement.

3. Except as herein provided, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
