

Accomplishments:

- October 19, 2023: OPBA CEO Exchange and kickoff at the Marine & Defense Technology Hub, St. Petersburg
- January 18, 2024: First OPBA Meeting and Engagement Session - Collaborative breakout tables and assessment of industry priorities to inform PCED's Strategic Plan. Priorities identified:
 - Workforce Housing that is affordable
 - Talent Development
 - Coordination of Services, local and regional for business retention, attraction/incentives.





Accomplishments (continued):

 April 10, 2024: Engagement Session and cross-departmental collaboration with Housing and Community Development to discuss SB Friedman's housing needs assessment. Discussion centered on workforce housing and informed County's projected housing demand study and future housing summit.

- July 18, 2024: Engagement Session:
 Workforce skills assessment, stakeholder collaborative lab, and skills gap report. This session focused on:
 - Priorities for new workforce development services initiative.
 - Workforce/talent development and regional competitiveness.
