Description & Comments

(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.)

The St. Pete-Clearwater International Airport (PIE) is seeking approval of a Fiscal Year 2026 (FY26) project application to request \$95,202.00 from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) under the Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant Program. The grant will enable PIE to fund 36 vehicle movement area transmitters (VMATS) which will be installed and configured to airport vehicles and equipment that access the airfield. 90.0% of the cost will be covered by the grant (\$95,292.00) and 10% will be covered by PIE (\$10,578.00). This is due to the FAA's response to an incident in March 2026 involving a fire rescue vehicle at LaGuardia colliding with an Air Canada jet, killing two pilots.

This is requested in the FY27 Budget of PIE in the Airport Revenue and Operating Fund. Depending on when the final agreement is signed, funds could be received in FY26 or FY27. Procurement of the remaining equipment will be in FY27. In the event that future fiscal year funding is not available for this agreement, the County maintains the authority to terminate this agreement.
