



In the early 2000's, the City of Clearwater wanted to keep alive the tradition of celebrating veterans' holidays. The mayor at that time called upon the veteran community to pick up the challenge.


This "challenge" established the organization now known as the Tampa Bay Veterans Alliance. More recently, the collaboration between Tampa Bay Vets Alliance and the City of Clearwater has resulted in the creation of the Florida Veterans Memorial Plaza at Crest Lake Park. The latest enhancement to the Plaza came with the state legislature creating the Purple Heart Trail designation for State Route 60 from the Courtney Campbell Causeway to Clearwater Beach. The Florida Veterans Memorial Plaza is recognition for all who have honorably served our country, those with us and those who have died. It's no coincidence the Wall at the Memorial brings to mind the Vietnam Wall in Washington, DC.



This is the registration form for you to memorialize your veteran forever at the Florida Veterans Memorial in Clearwater, FL. The memorial tiles will be black granite with silver letters, and will be placed on the walls that encircle the memorial. You will be able to submit two lines with a maximum of 20 characters per line for each 12" x 4" section of granite tile at the memorial.

There are a limited number of tiles available for you to purchase at the memorial, so it is important to submit your registration form as soon as possible. Only the first 1000 submissions will be guaranteed a location on the interior walls of the memorial. Upon verification of the name and military service of the veteran to be honored we will notify you

We can verify service with a DD214, VFW membership, American Legion membership or similar VSO that has previously verified the service of the veteran.
