Description & Comments

This is for the approval of 1-year joint funding agreement with the United States Geological Survey (USGS), Department of Interior for the Caribbean-Florida Water Science Center Water Resource Investigations. USGS has constructed and installed data gathering stations at various locations throughout the County to collect continuous monitoring data, including flood stages, discharge, and rainfall. Data is utilized to meet the County's National Pollution Discharge Elimination System stormwater permit water quality requirements, watershed planning and stormwater modeling, and flood forecasting. The 1-year agreement is for the period of May 1, 2024, to April 30, 2025. The County will contribute \$236,974.00 and the USGS will contribute \$71,726.00. Total agreement is \$308.700.00.

Funding for the \$236,974 is consistent and included in the FY24 Adopted budget and FY25 Request. Funding will be split between the Environmental Management Division for \$214,343.00 and the Public Works Operations & Watershed Planning for \$22,631.00 for a total County contribution of \$236,974.00. The USGS will contribute the remaining \$71,726.00.
