pre-disaster conditions. A minimum reimbursement of 75.0% of eligible cost is provided by FEMA and 12.5% by the												
State to primarily address the repair and restoration of public facilities and infrastructure which have been damaged												
or destroyed, and the restoration of services which were negatively impacted. The remaining 12.5% is the responsibility of the County as local matching funds.
