This is a resolution authorizing the County Administrator to annually execute the Certification Statement of the Use of Certified Public Funds and Letter of Agreement with the State of Florida to participate in the Medicaid Public Emergency Medical Transportation (PEMT) and Medicaid Public Emergency Medical Transportation-Intergovernmental Transfer Programs (PEMT-IGT) which provides supplemental revenue to public ambulance transportation providers for services rendered to Medicaid recipients. The application and approval process is required annually and the timeline for approval is short. This resolution allows the County Administer to sign that agreement within the shortened timeline.

Projected revenue is \$5,100,000.00 per year; PEMT (\$400,000) and PEMT-IGT (\$4.7M) and is consistent and included in the FY23 Adopted budget and will be included in future years' budgets.
