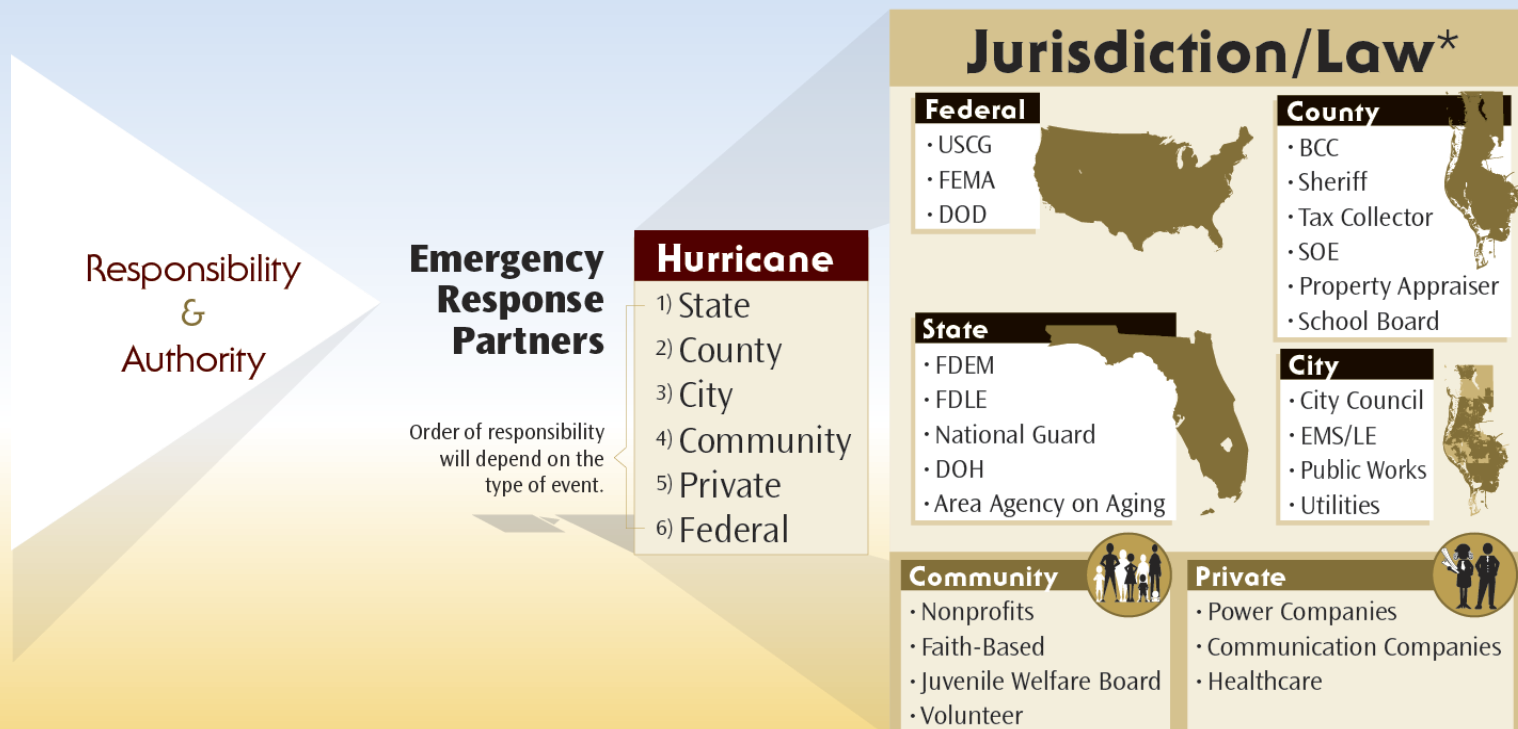

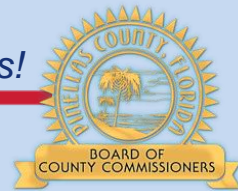

Board of County Commissioners

- Official Board Action to protect lives and property
- Designation of Official Authority to head the EOC Executive Policy Group
- Availability to convene as Board for official Board Actions as needed in post event environment
- Official Spokesperson
