

Steps to Launch Programs



Action Plan Requirements

The County must submit a high-level "Action Plan" to HUD for acceptance before any programs can start. It must include:

- ✓ Disaster impact overview
- ✓ Unmet needs assessment
- ✓ Mitigation needs assessment
- ✓ Program categories that address unmet needs or mitigation
- ✓ Budgets that are "proportionate" to identified unmet needs
- ✓ Public and stakeholder input

Determining Unmet Needs & Mitigation Needs

HUD expects an analysis based on many sources to ensure that it is fact based.

Unmet Needs/Mitigation Needs Assessment Data Sources
