A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA; VACATING THE NORTH ONE HALF OF THE SIXTY-FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY KNOWN AS RUSSELL AVENUE, LYING ADJACENT TO LOT 11, BLOCK 5, MUNDAY'S ADDITION TO CHESTERVILLA, PLAT BOOK 21, PAGE 22, LYING IN SECTION 33-29-16; RETAINING A TEN-FOOT WIDE UTILITY EASEMENT OVER THE NORTHERN PORTION OF THE VACATED RIGHT-OF-WAY AND A DRAINAGE EASEMENT OVER THE VACATED PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Joseph McDonald and Alexandria McDonald (the Petitioners) have petitioned this Board of County Commissioners to vacate the following described property:

WHEREAS, the Petitioners have shown that the vacation of such portions of the plat will not affect the ownership or right of convenient access of persons owning other parts of the subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioners' affidavit has been received by the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida that the above described property and plat be hereby vacated, insofar as this Board of County Commissioners has the authority to do so, pursuant to §336.09, Florida Statutes, subject to the retention of a ten-foot wide utility easement over the northern portion of the vacated right-of-way and a drainage easement over the vacated property.

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board of County Commissioners shall adopt this resolution with authorization for the Clerk to record in the Public Records of Pinellas County, Florida.
