Description & Comments

Grant agreement between Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) and Pinellas County to provide funding for Capital Improvement Program project 004487A - Long Key-Upham 2024 Beach Nourishment. Agreement 23PI1 begins January 1st, 2022 and expires December 31st, 2025.

This project is a Pinellas County Shore Protection Project to be designed and constructed by United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and monitored by a County selected vendor. Costs for USACE phases are shared between the federal entity (USACE at 64%) and nonfederal entities (State and County total 32%). The nonfederal share is split between State and County at 50% and includes 32% of the USACE multiphase project and all monitoring activities. FDEP's 50% cost share is not to exceed \$1,325,000.00.

- 004487A Long Key-Upham 2024 Beach Nourishment is budgeted in the FY23-FY28 Capital Improvement Program plan.
 - Project is funded by Tourist Development Tax (County Share) and State grant through FDEP agreement 23PI1, once executed (State Share)
 - 50/50 cost share between State and County is represented in the Capital Improvement Program plan.
- There is sufficient budget in the FY23-FY28 CIP plan to support the latest project estimates.
- An agreement amendment is anticipated, post construction, to shift unspent design and construction funding to the monitoring task. This potential amendment would not increase the total project cost or requested funding.
- Original agreement start date 7/1/22. Requested revision to start that would predate March 2022. This is when the County received the first demand letter from USACE. Payments from FDEP are cost-reimbursement based. The County provides pre-payment to USACE for nonfederal project share. County must provide payment requests/demand letters from USACE, invoices from monitoring vendors, and proof of payment.
 - Revised agreement obtained and attached to Legistar file. New start date 1/1/22 but Staff Report was not updated to reflect this. OMB will edit this information in Staff Report.
