Authorization will commit the County to providing the required local matching funds for the South Cross Bayou Water Reclamation Facility High Service Pump Station Improvements project if it receives funding through the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's 2026 Resilient Florida Grant Program, subject to grant approval and the County's budget process. The letter affirms the County's commitment to funding the local match, completing the project, and complying with all grant requirements to improve resilience against flooding, sea level rise, storm surge, and other climate-related impacts.

A minimum of 50% matching funds is required. A matching funds commitment letter, signed by the BCC Chairman, is required to be submitted with the application.

Matching funds are available under South Cross Bayou AWRP High Service Pump Station Improvements project 002941A, included in the Proposed FY27-FY32 Capital Improvement Plan, funded by the Sewer Renewal and Replacement Fund in the amount of \$41,824,000.00.
