On behalf of the applicant agency named below, I certify the following to the Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of Justice:

- (A) That approximately 10 % portion of funding shall be used to carry out for inclusion in the Combined DNA Index System (CODIS), DNA analyses of samples collected under applicable legal authority;
- (B) That approximately 80 % [shall be a minimum of 40% of the award amount] portion of funding shall be used to carry out, for inclusion in CODIS, DNA analyses of samples from crime scenes.
- (C) That approximately 10 % portion of funding shall be used to increase the capacity of the laboratory to carry out DNA analyses of database and/or crime scene samples for inclusion in CODIS; [all highlighted sections must be filled in with numeric values and the sum of all three shall equal 100]
