Approval of the notice of a grant award from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) for COVID-19 American Rescue Plan Act funding for the Health Care for the Homeless program.

This award provides one-time funding in the amount of \$1,567,250.00 to support activities to plan, prepare for, promote, distribute, administer, and track COVID-19 vaccines, and carry out other vaccine-related activities. The County is working with the Florida Department of Health and Health Care for the Homeless Co-Applicant Board to determine the best use of funds to prepare for and respond to the coronavirus disease amongst the homeless population in Pinellas County. Project 90007E1 has been setup in OPUS for this grant.

This grant does not require any matching funds. These funds were not anticipated during the development of the FY21 budget. A budget amendment for FY21 will be brought forward separately, if needed. Appropriation to support related grant activities is consistent with the development of the FY22 Proposed budget.
