

AFTER-THE-FACT PERMITTING (Compliance Efforts)

- Initial surge in activity; pace has since slowed
- Positive feedback from residents utilizing nopenalty permitting
- Florida Building Code (FBC) Permit Records (thru 11/26): 286
- Floodplain Mobile Home Permit Records (as of 11/26): 220
- Outreach conducted at: Westwind, Seahorse, Crystal Bay, Coquina Cove, Edgewater Pines and Grand Bay. Two (2) corporate owned communities remaining including Sun Retreat (12/4) and Gateway.



Changes to Support Recovery Efforts



1. Substantially Damaged Structure Compliance Date

- Proposed "blanket extension" from June 1, 2026 to December 31, 2026
 - Allows time for reassessments, SDE disputes, appeals, and recovery planning
 - Marks a gradual wind-down of compliance efforts; further extension possible
 - BDRS to focus on after-the-fact compliance through June 1, 2026, then shift to SD compliance through December 31, 2026

Changes to Support Recovery Efforts (cont.)





2. Activate Chapter 158-301 for Mobile Homes

 Activate utilization of temporary placement of RV's within Mobile Home Communities within a regulated floodplain for up to 180days

Changes to Support Recovery Efforts (cont.)



3. Special Magistrate Appeals Extension (and supporting reassessments process and appeals cases)

 Existing agreement with Clerk's office to be extended to September 30, 2026 for floodplain appeals process


4. Extend Waiving of 2x Normal Permit Fee

- Extend from December 31, 2025 to June 30, 2026 to further incentivize compliance associated with after-the-fact permits
- Timing correlated to participation in pursuing recovery funding
- Timing correlated to enforcement approach
