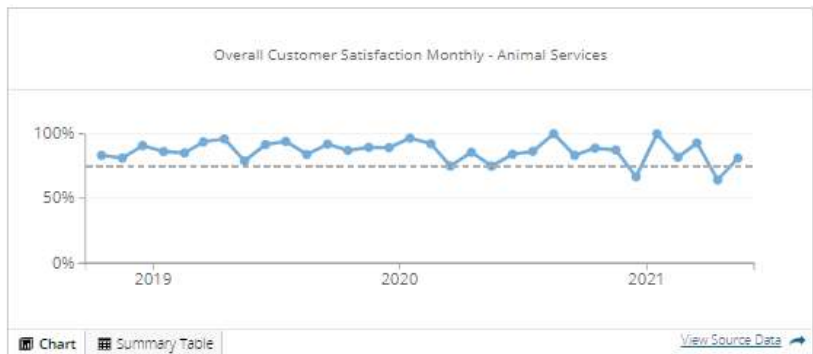
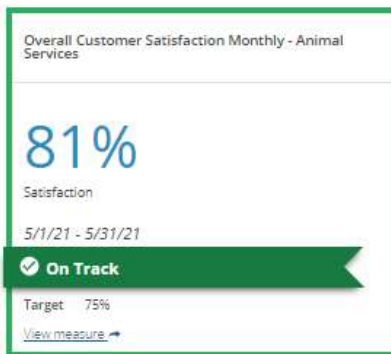
Purpose

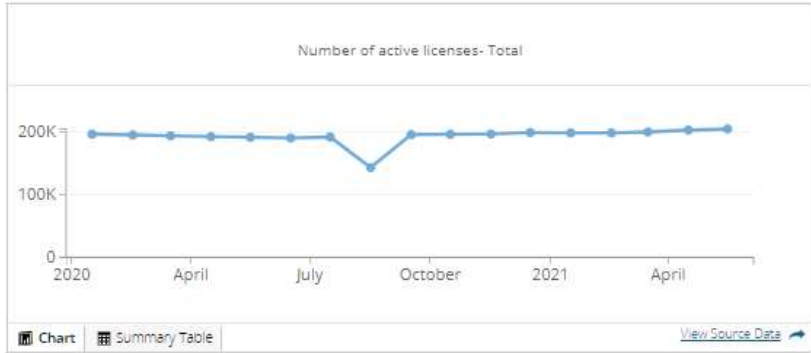

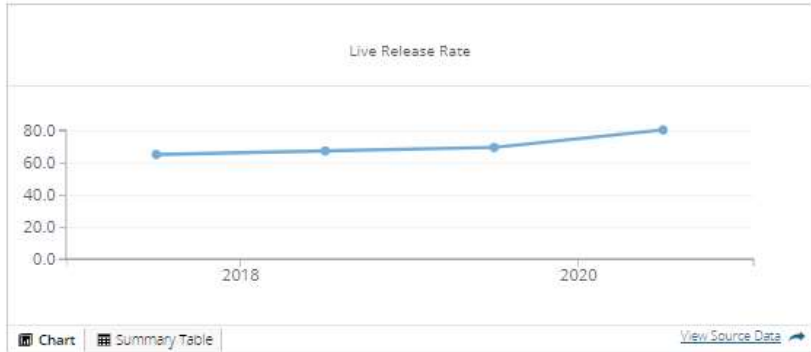

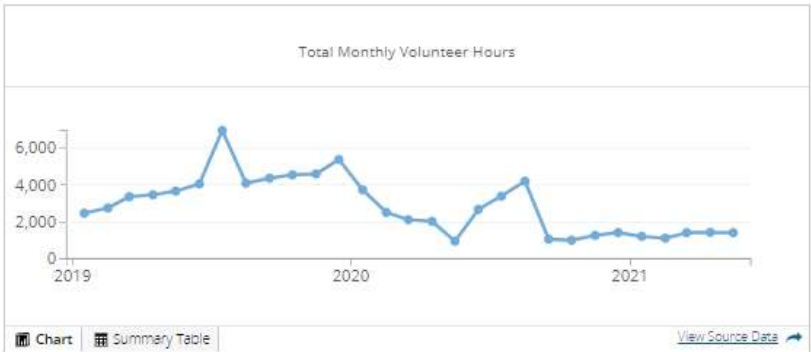

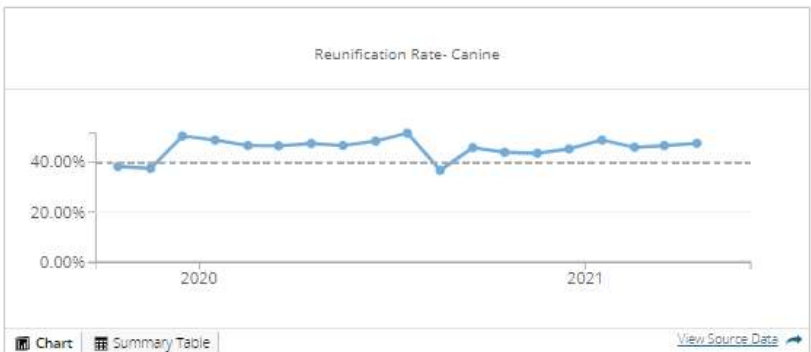
