These are some observations I've made. I have photos that I took during my lunch hour on Friday, 4-7-23. When traffic is heavy (especially during spring break and on Fridays), people drive south in the center lane (oncoming traffic) to make a double right turn onto Court St. I propose turning the northbound traffic into one lane, and make southbound traffic 2 lanes from Franklin to Court St to allow this to be done legally. If this cannot be done, then I propose putting a median between the lanes, although I suspect the larger vehicles will just drive over it.
