

PUBLIC LIBRARY COOPERATIVE









The Public Library Cooperative (PLC) is primarily supported by a dedicated property tax levy. The current rate of 0.5000 mill has not changed since FY14. The annual payment to the PLC supports administrative expenses (approximately 10.0%) and payments to the 14 member libraries. The payments are intended to provide funding support in recognition of the services provided by the member libraries to unincorporated residents who are assessed the PLC millage. Distribution of funds among the member libraries is based on a formula reflected in the interlocal agreement that leverages a combination of local support (90%) and non-resident circulation (10%). There are no significant program changes anticipated for the PLC budget in FY25. Projected revenues reflect an anticipated increase in taxable property values, and with appropriation of available fund balance, FY25 payments to the PLC for administration and distribution to the member libraries increase by \$618,300 (7.8%) over the FY24 budget.

PINELLAS PUBLIC LIBRARY COOPERATIVE

The Public Library Cooperative (PLC) serves eligible residents of Pinellas County and its member public libraries. The Cooperative serves these groups through the management of county, state and outside grant funds for library development and by facilitating the sharing of materials and resources among its members. The Cooperative is funded by a millage levy in a portion of the unincorporated areas of the county and per capita dues paid by the participating municipalities without libraries. The maximum millage rate that can be levied is 0.5000 mills.
