The Human Services Department requests approval and execution by the County Administrator of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and supplemental certification form to be submitted with the Community Action Stops Abuse (CASA) grant application to the U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) solicitation for improving criminal justice responses.

CASA is seeking to submit an application under the USDOJ OVW Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 solicitation for Improving Criminal Justice Responses to pursue a local Family Justice Center program to improve services for victims of inter-personal violence. In order to apply, CASA is required to submit an executed MOU and associated certification from local government demonstrating partnerships

Under roles & responsibilities, C. iii. states that City and SPPD's obligations shall be more specifically laid out in an addendum to this MOU in the event CASA is awarded the Grant. Is the same true for the Pinellas County obligations? This language was specifically requested by City of St. Petersburg and was included in their section. For the overall contract the bottom of Page 3 references:

"The above constitutes the initial understanding of participating partners for Family Justice Center planning. This MOU may be amended from time to time or additional agreements may be established as determined necessary and appropriate by the partners for the Family Justice Center program. The above stated conditions are understood and agreed upon by the undersigned."

Any future obligations or consideration would require an amendment which would go through contract review.

No budgetary impacts are anticipated from the execution of this MOU.
