AND 13-30-15, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA;
RETAINING A UTILITY EASEMENT OVER THE
ENTIRE VACATED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Pinellas County seeks to vacate the following described property:

WHEREAS, upon review, it appears that the vacation of such portions of the plat will not affect the ownership or right of convenient access of persons owning other parts of the subdivision.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida that the above described property and plat be vacated, insofar as this Board of County Commissioners has the authority to do so, pursuant to §336.09, Florida Statutes, subject to the retention of a utility easement over the entire vacated area.

NOW BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Board of County Commissioners shall adopt this resolution with authorization for the Clerk to record in the Public Records of Pinellas County, Florida.
