AWARDING OF INCENTIVE FUNDS FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2020

The Department of Revenue Child Support Program earns federal incentive funds based on its performance in providing services to families. Each year, the Program shares a portion of the incentive earnings with local governments that participate in the cost of the Program through agreements with the Program. The Program has agreements with the Clerk of the Circuit Court and the Sheriff's office in your county.

The Program is awarding incentive earnings to the political subdivisions according to Title 45 Code of Federal Regulations §302.55 and the approved Child Support State Incentive Allocation Plan. Incentive funds payment must be used to support child support services provided to the Child Support Program by the Clerk of the Circuit Court and the Sheriff's office (Title 45 CFR §305.35). These payments are federal funds and the CFDA number for your reporting purposes is 93.563.

Enclosed is a copy of the calculations used in determining Pinellas County's incentive payment for \$10297. Based upon the method of payment chosen during your county's registration with the Department of Financial Services, either a warrant is enclosed, or the amount was sent by way of an electronic funds transfer (EFT). Please ensure the appropriate accounting/financial personnel are aware of this payment and receive a copy of this letter and enclosures.
