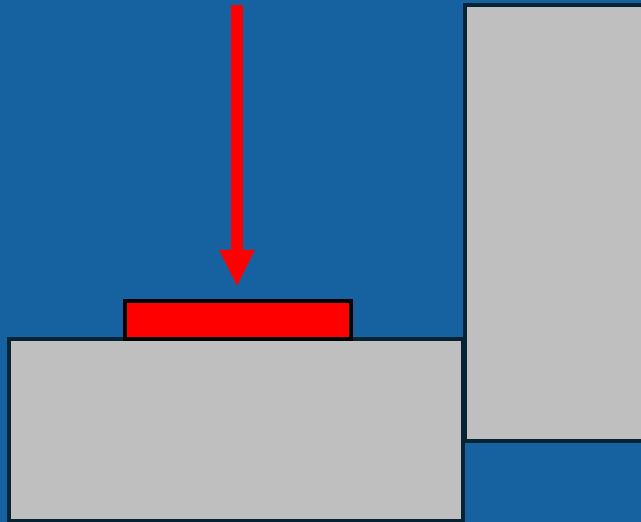

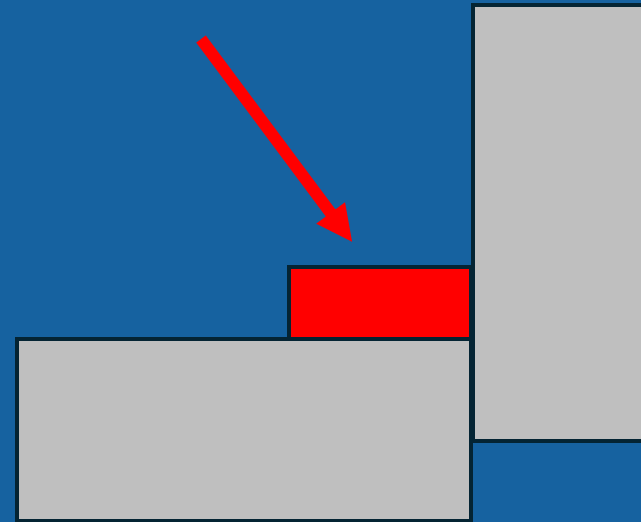
Design Concepts

Option 1 (Center)



- Classical entry style
- Justice wing anchors the campus composition
- Central campus axis
- Reinforces symmetry

Option 2 (Corner)



- Facilitates efficient circulation to both wings
- Strengthens connectivity to the plaza through views from the main lobby
- Creates a shared focal point at the intersection of the two wings

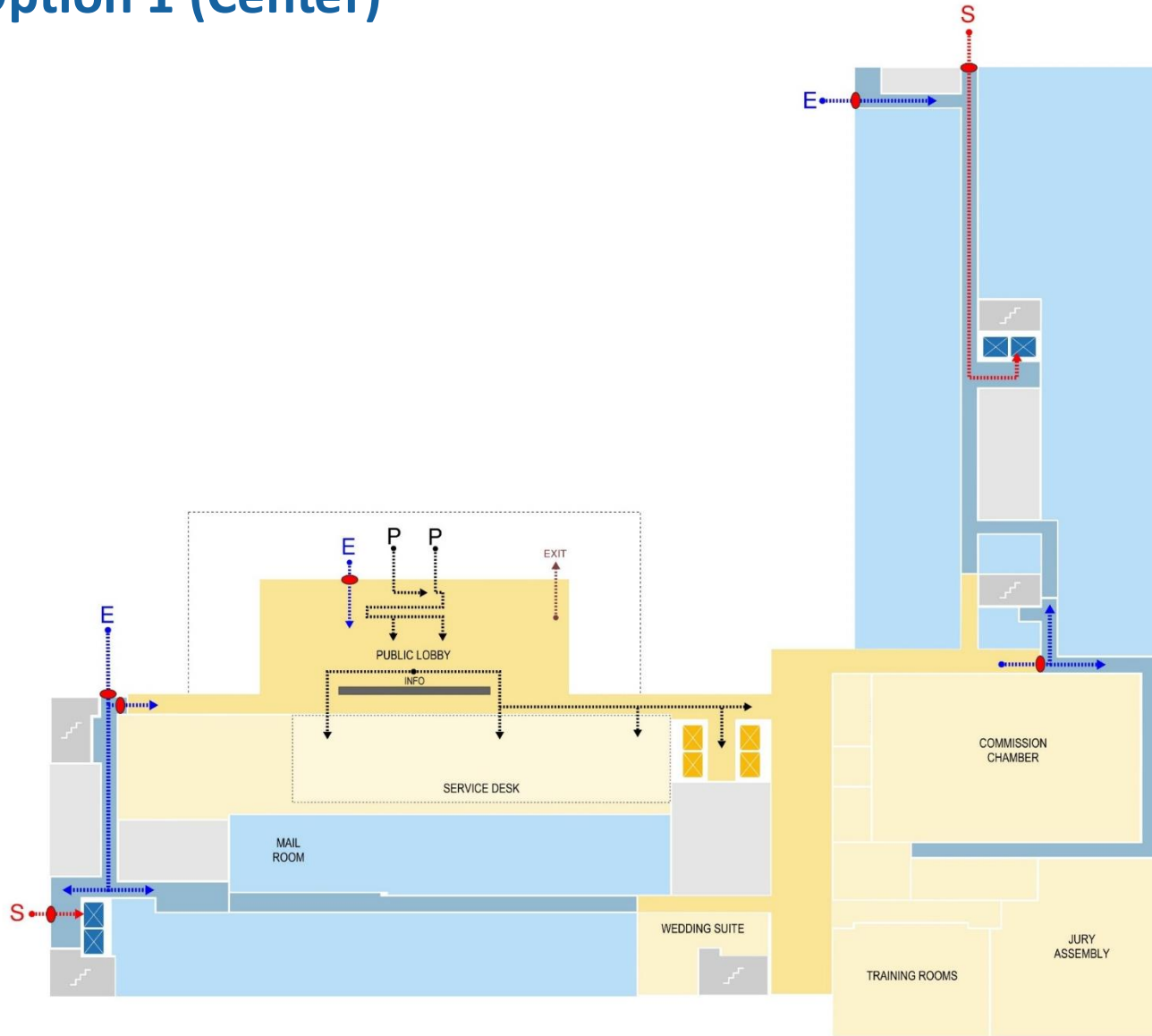

Plan Diagram - Level 1

Interiors / Exterior Considerations:

- Direct access from security entry to service desk
- Dedicated arrival/security screening sequence,
- Unencumbered public lobby and vertical circulation
- Prominent public lobby and screening pulled into civic courtyard

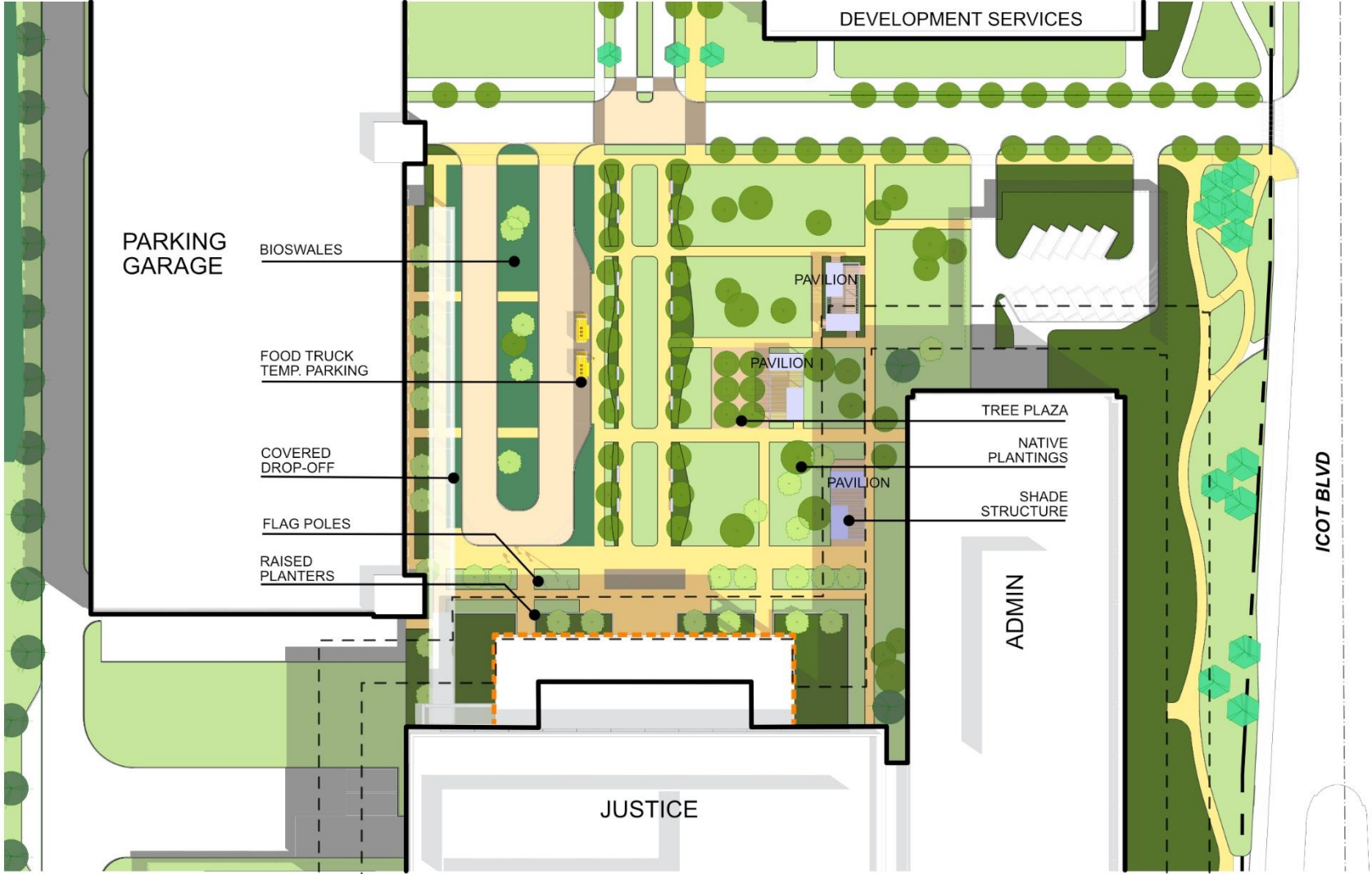


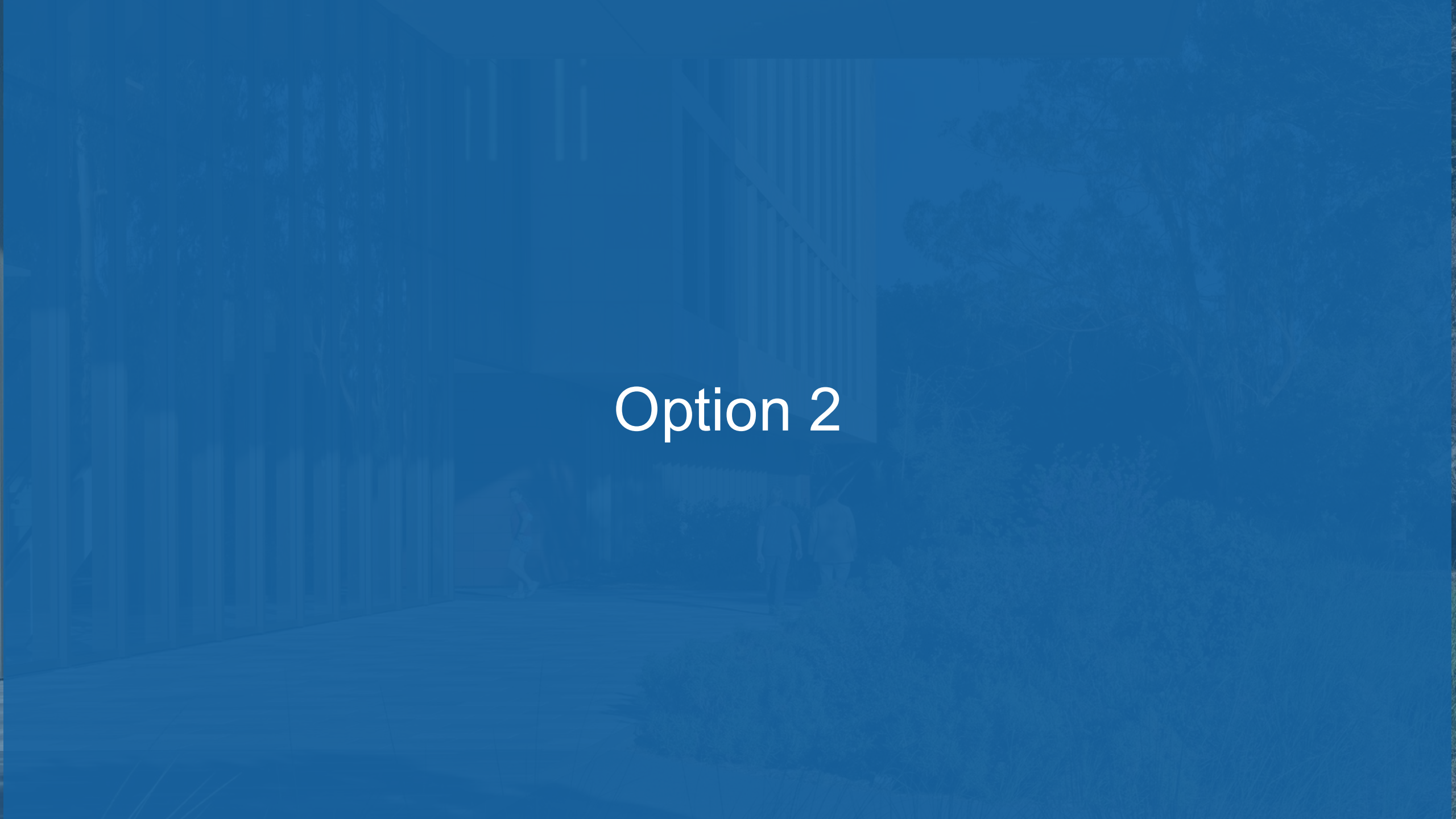

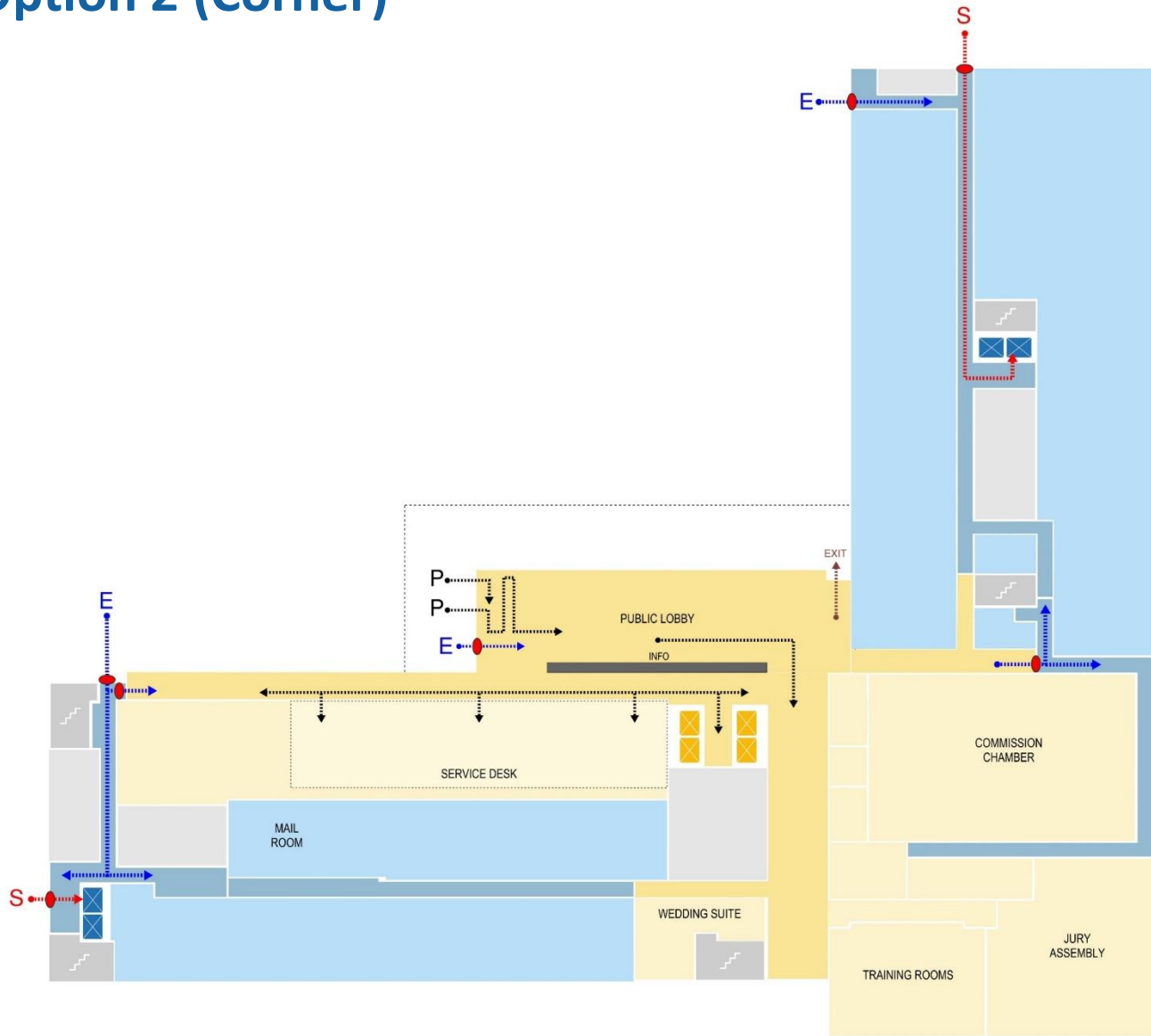

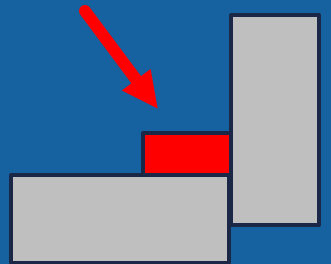
