(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.) This grant provides funding to the Sheriff for the procurement of a 25' vessel for the Marine Unit. The total grant is \$200,925 and will be split with the City of St. Petersburg.

- The JAG Local provides recurring federal criminal justice funding from the Bureau for Justice Assistance (BJA) for allocation to the City of St. Petersburg (St. Pete) and Pinellas County Sheriff's Office (PCSO).
- Each year the County, PCSO, and St. Pete enter into a MOU and submit a joint application to allow for an equal division of the award and avoid a disparate allocation of grant funding.
- \$200,925.00 in funding is provided by the JAG Local solicitation. PCSO and St. Pete will each receive \$100,462.50 with PCSO serving as the fiscal administrator.
- PCSO will utilize grant to fund the Raptor Technologies Reunification software and annual access fee for countywide license and includes Raptor technical support. Designed to enhance and streamline the reunification process and offers an integrated platform that facilitates efficient communication and coordination during critical events for law enforcement and first responders. St. Pete will utilize its allocation to sustain and continue several crime prevention, community policing, and law enforcement initiatives.
- No Match is required.

This grant is consistent with the FY24 Proposed Budget submission from PCSO.
