### Description & Comments

This is the approval of the First Amendment to the grant agreement with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for the Vulnerability Assessment (VA) Phase II. The amendment provides an additional grant reimbursement amount of \$1,353,000.00. Total grant funding in the amount of \$2,053,000.00 and extends the Agreement date from December 31, 2024, to December 30, 2026.

The \$1,353,000 increase in funding is consistent with the FY25 Adopted Budget. A budget amendment may be needed to recognize the revenues and expenditures associated with the grant increase depended on activity within FY25. Currently \$185,000 is budgeted for in FY25. No County match is required.
