

RESOLUTION NO. 26-37

RESOLUTION APPROVING VOTING PRECINCT CHANGES
AS RECOMMENDED BY THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, Section 101.001(1), Florida Statutes, provides that the Board of County Commissioners, upon recommendation and approval by the Supervisor of Elections, shall alter or create election precincts; and

WHEREAS, Julie Marcus, as Pinellas County Supervisor of Elections (Supervisor) has recommended and approved adjusting certain precincts; and

WHEREAS, a modification is being made to accommodate the 2026 redistricting of Florida Congressional districts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, in regular session duly assembled this 19th day of May, 2026, that the precinct changes set forth by the Supervisor are hereby established.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that within ten (10) days of these changes and pursuant to Section 101.001(4), the Supervisor will make in writing an accurate description of any new or altered precincts, setting forth the boundary lines and will identify the location of each new or altered polling place. In accordance with the requirements of Florida Statutes, the Supervisor will submit to the Secretary of State written descriptions and revised precinct boundary maps. The Supervisor will also post this information at their offices.
