The Yellow Dot Critical Motorist Medical Information Program provides personal health information to First Responders in the event that the program participant is injured in their vehicle. By participating in this program and providing medical information, First Responders will be able to review a participant's basic medical information including current medications and preexisting medical conditions and consider that information when emergency medical treatment is being administered to the participant.

Each participant will receive a yellow dot decal to place on the lower left corner of their vehicle's rear window, a yellow dot folder, and a form where the participant provides personal and medical information. The information provided includes the participants name, photograph, emergency contact information, medical information, allergies, current medications, hospital preference, and physician information.

First Responder agencies that decide to participate in the program will cover any associated program costs. Sponsorships may be solicited from businesses and non-profit organizations to cover program costs. Participants cannot be charged a fee to participate in the program. There is no anticipated cost to the county.
